Keynote Address delivered by Professor Barika Dominic Saro-Laka, the Secretary-General of the Association of United Nations Ambassadors for Peace (ASUNAP) at the Inaugural Induction and Technical Workshop for Global Peace Advocates and Development Catalysts for the commemoration of the UN declared 2024 International Day of Peace held at Abuja, Nigeria

Peace is life. It emits the oxygen for the sustenance of life. It is ONLY a living organism that can be described as being precious, beautiful or handsome. Peace, is, indeed, the origin and taproot of everything that gives energy or strength to the world. Without peace, every human plan or activity fails, remains static or unaccomplished. Peace is the strong basis for societal survival and it has an invisible innate power that make everything in our environment tap strength for resilient survival, vibrancy as well as for growth, development and progress.

This postulation collaborates the learned position of a global icon of peace, Her Excellency, Professor Margaret King, OBE, when she noted that: "Peace is everything to the world. Let's embrace and advocate it at everywhere and time."

The absence of peace signals or introduces disorganization, stagnation and dearth of ideas. Of all virtues or qualities of life, it is ONLY peace that supplies for the contemplation of investments in any given entity or clime for the eventual bashing of poverty, unemployment, indolence, and despondency.

Truth be told, there is no current of force that can withstand business oddities and vagaries in an atmosphere that is devoid of peace. It, therefore, symbolizes the rock or pillar upon, which mountains so stand and assume intensity of advantages for citizens in the global space.

Again, it is raw deceit and a dangerous assumption to believe that collective economic prosperity can be realized in a non-peaceful and violent environment.

Let me dramatise a bit on this pertinent matter. During the pick of the social menace of kidnapping in the Niger Delta region of Nigeria, majority of blue-chip companies and oil majors, including IOCs were forced to shut down operations whilst some of these multi-national firms relocated their operations from Nigeria to other African countries. What was responsible for the cautious and wise actions of the management teams of these commercial giants? Nothing else than lack of peace!

The huge madness from these iconoclasts or enemies of progress as well as elements of decay were felt in large-scale loss of jobs, abrupt closure of micro and small businesses as well as the stiffling of supplies, which local enterprises hitherto enjoyed. The charade also punctured the wheel of nano businesses that drew strength - raw materials and support from those commercial giants while the ratio of hunger and frustration ballooned.

When insecurity and banditry picked up in Northern Nigeria as a result of the disturbances of Boko Haram, billions of Naira worth of property were lost as well as thousands of precious and innocent lives. Successive governments have been unable to stop the carnage and so lives are still being lost today.

Disruption of means of livelihood and payment of ransom for kidnapped citizens or victims of brute force ceased the beauty of life. Also, the sit-at-home order, in the fashion of military fiat, by the Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB) in the Eastern Region of Nigeria, aggravated an unfortunate and heavy situation of loss, waste and social misery in the region. Businesses operating in that axis of Nigeria were forced to shut industries and shops on Mondays whilst non-compliant owners of companies and enterprises had their commercial vehicles looted or burnt and their manpower thoroughly beaten.

If you ask an expert in War Studies like Dr. Kayode Fayemi, former Governor of Ekiti State, he would be quick to equate these three scenarios with mild war.

The cumulative effect of the inability of government and stakeholders to implement a marshall

plan of action to abate these elements of impunity and idiosyncrasies is the root cause and partly a contributing factor to the grinding hunger and poverty in Nigeria today. And it is sadly unfortunate that the absence of peace is causing social unrest and even instigating social disobedience in the Nigerian system, at the moment.

For example, in order to douse and weaken the roving spirit of injustice and marginalisation in Nigeria, the sure bet is to simply recognize what I could describe as the fourth missing leg and run all national opportunities and privileges on that understanding. The present manner of recognition on the prism of Yoruba, Hausa and Igbo alone is defective, false and provocative. The population and landmass of all the other tribal groups in Nigeria joined with the fourth largest ethnic group called the Tivs are larger and bigger than many of the so called majority ethnic groups. Since the Tivs are spread across Benue, Niger, Adamawa, Plateau, Kogi, Nasarawa, and Taraba States as well as in the Federal Capital Territory (FCT), is it not a point of logical conscience for the Federal Government of Nigeria (FGN), the Federal Character Commission (FCC) and the Federal Civil Service Commission (FCSC) to be accorded the status of the Fourth Majority Group with His Majesty, Professor James lyatse, the Tor Tiv, recognised and made to serve as the Head of this constituent ethnic machinery? This proposal is certain to project and strengthen the energy for the synergy of a more united, peaceful and prosperous Nigeria.

Frankly speaking, Nigeria, as a country of over 250 heterogeneous ethnic groups, with variety of cultures and spoken dialects and being the largest Black nation in the world, has not taken SERIOUS and consistent steps, aimed at uniting the nation and cultivating the seeds of national reconciliation and peace in its system.

For example, the people of the South-East Region are still being marginalised and deprived of funds for speedy development. The region is suffering from lopsided state-structure whereas the North-West Region that brings very little contributions to the national table has a seven state-structure. In fact, it has more Local Government Areas that draw huge monthly financial resources direct from the federation.

The South-South Region that brings heavy monthly contributions to the national treasury is even the worst hit by neglect and impoverishment as it is left with only a six state-structure, instead of getting, at least, nine states. This brutal anomaly is seriously affecting motivation, which is a key factor for robust national productivity.

Also, the psychological balance of the South-Southerners, in the federation, is shaky and weak while the people have no bearing with a true sense of national belonging and integration.

In like manner, national and global peace can only be guaranteed in an atmosphere of deliberate promotion and implementation of meritocracy as well as a sanction and workable reward system, as a matter of priority and policy.

The population of widows in Nigeria is estimated to be about 20% of the entire population in the country. Yet, my pleas for the establishment of the National Widowhood Trust Fund for them has remained unheeded. They wield similar population figures in other African and foreign countries of the world and so all governments should establish agencies that could humanise and dignify widows. What is their crime that they are so much neglected and persecuted in the global society and forcing the seizure of prayers

All heterogeneous or contending interest groups MUST hold the stability of our fatherland dearly at heart and evolve ideas and strategies that could enhance and deepen the growth and advancement of the federation.

Peace is the ONLY raw material that fertilises the soil of the earth and guarantees bounteous harvests at due seasons. Like love, peace recognises no barriers; it jumps all hurdles; leaps fences and valleys; penetrates walls, including the Wall of Jericho; to arrive at its destination, full of hope and in raw accomplishment of mission.

Peace is the golden tonic for calming bruised nerves. Peace is beautiful as it gives birth to decorum and orderliness. The human psyche operates at the level and speed of misery in the absence of peace. The human body is patterned for optimal productivity, first, and ONLY, when peace is available in the soul, body and spirit of that organic system (human being). Yes, peace is the rugged weapon upon which the world experiences global harmony, synergy and rapid growth. Please, join me to re-echo and trumpet the truism that the world's quest for collective prosperity and sustainable development remain elusive and a mirage in an environment or clime lacking an iota of peace.

Psychological training and re-orientation is important in the process of peace-building in the society. And I think this is where pundits affirm that the Director-General of the National Orientation Agency (NOA), Mallam Lanre Issa Onilu got it right in his sensitive counsel themed "Nigeria: We Must All Face The Truth." Also proper management of information and timeliness for dissemination of information are paramount factors in the value-chain of engendering the cultivation of the seeds of peace in the universe.

Wrong or sad news broken to people, without the utility of the matching wisdom of mood or timeliness of action, can cease their peace. This situation induces psychological torture and could cause a person to slump and die.

In 1996, there was a patient (name withheld) whose blood sample taken for test was unintentionally swapped at the Laboratory Room. When the result of the wrong test came out, Mr. Patient was said to be HIV positive. The new doctor that resumed duty at the Ward of the Government hospital was conducting medical analysis and discovered that the result of the patient cannot be his own. Few seconds later, the Laboratory Team, rushed in to apologize and declare it as an error. Prior to this stage, the patient had been devastated and heart-broken. Within few hours, all his body system had broken down. He couldn't sleep or eat again. He became, within one week, emaciated to the extent that he couldn't walk by himself again. He was on the way to piece-meal death because peace had been recklessly taken from his life. This illustration highlights the importance of peace in human life and society.

Like late minority rights activist and Baptist preacher, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., once, espoused: "Injustice done to anyone is injustice done to all." Peace is like a rocket phenomenon, which latent force cannot be controlled. In this sense, therefore, the absence of peace in the life of any person or nation, means the absence of peace in the family unit of a community, and by extension, in the global society.

By emphasis, the family is a minute unit of a state while a state is a minute unit of a country. Also, it is like the teeth and tongue that are always glued together. Or, the case of someone that lives in a glass house and thus don't need to throw stones to hit passersby. So, is the relationship between peace and the entire society.

See how God attaches great importance to peace, in His Holy Book, called the Holy Bible: "The latter glory of this house will be greater than the former", says the Lord of hosts, 'and in this place, I will give peace, declares the Lord of hosts." - Haggai 2:9.

Also see an intriguing capture of the essence of peace and tolerance by the Holy Quran. The Holy Quran discloses that peace is one of the names of God Himself: "He is God other than Whom there is no God, the King, the Holy, the Peace, the Defender, the Guardian, the Mighty, the Omnipotent, the Supreme." - Quran 59:23.

The Quran emphasizes the development of the culture of peace and a non-violent society. A distinguished Nigerian patriot and irrepressible peace advocate, Alhaji Yusuf Ali, SAN, has continually amplified and campaign Islam's position on world peace and collective prosperity. Peace, according to him, is the root of growth and development. It is also an effective source for effective planning, wealth creation and sustainable progress. The legal titan emphasizes Islam's priority on peace as the primary law and non-violence while also campaigning against the exploitation and abuse of women in the society.

It is only people that have not heard the echoes of war drums or the roaring sounds of flying bullets or experienced the devastating harm and/or witnessed the dangers of war that will treat the necessity for peace with levity or make it a joking matter. Even though the fratricidal Nigeria-Biafra War lasted for only three years from 1967 to 1970, humanity is still feeling its negative effect till today; wounds are yet to heal while billions of Naira worth of property and other kinds of investments lost to it can NEVER be recovered.

If I narrate the sequences of the consequences of the Rwandan War between the Hutu and Tutsi ethnic nationalities, so many people, especially Rwandans, might not believe me. So, it is better we listen to the narration of a first-hand actor, incumbent President Paul Kagame of Rwanda or those of some other key actors in that war.

According to the United Nations, 800,000 Rwandans were killed in the three-month genocide. The 1994 genocide against against the Tutsi people in Rwanda followed the aftermath of an attack on President Habyarimanda's plane where extremists Hutus began a concerted reprisal against the minority people of Tutsi in Rwanda. From April to July 1994, massacres were carried out by government forces as well as armed militia known as the Interahamwe.

The majority Hutus were unhappy that it colonisers, the Belgan Government, were favourable to the minority Tutsis and this unprovoked bitterness led to the Hutu revolution in 1959. Records show that as many as 330,000 Tutsis were forced to flee their country. By early 1961, according to records, victorious Hutus had forced Rwanda's Tutsi monarch into exile and declared the country a Republic. After the referendum undertaken by the United Nations that year, Belgium officially granted independence to Rwandans in July 1962.

The Libyan Civil War took place between 2014 and 2020. It was the 2nd Civil War in that country, aggravated by a number of armed groups, mainly by the House of Representatives (HoRs) and the Government of National Accord (GNA), for six years from 16th May, 2024 to 23rd October, 2020. The scale of havoc done to Libyan citizens and the associated waste is better imagined than felt. The profile of casualties and losses were alarming as 14,882 people were killed.

Liberians witnessed the first war that was provoked by the Samuel Doe's regime of excessive impunity and lawlessness. It lasted from 1989 to 1997 whilst the war ballooned due to massive corruption and human rights abuses under Doe's government. From 1997 when Charles Taylor overthrew Samuel Doe, loyal armed groups to both leaders clashed and it led to the 2nd Liberian Civil War under Charles Taylor. The economy worsened as hunger and lack crushed the citizens harder.

Between 1989 to 2003, the war wasted an estimated 150,000 to 250,000 Liberians and caused a mass of refugees and displaced population in the country on the scale of over half of the country's total population. Worst depth of human atrocities took place, including summary executions, conscription of child soldiers and sexual slavery.

By early 1990, several dozens of Liberians had fled the country and a large number of civilians and combatants were raped, tortured and killed, as government and rebel forces engaged in extended warfare.

The annexation of Crimea in early 2014 sparked off a dimension of Russian-Ukrainian cold War. However, the real war between the two countries was felt on 24th February, 2022. It remains the biggest war to be witnessed in a European country. Let the truth be told. The war between these countries seem to affect some external African countries more than the fighting duo. The war between these two heavily endowed agricultural giants has even aggravated global hunger, lack and misery in the world, with Nigeria that is yet to embrace full agricultural mechanisation and tech-driven storage and agro-allied preservation system worst hit.

Do you need a shocker confirmation? On 29th February, 2024, the United Nations World Food Programme, received 25,000 tons of wheat donated by the Government of Ukraine to the Government of Nigeria in order to reduce hunger and suffering in Nigeria. The simple logic in this

humanitarian gesture, which I am trying to buttress is that, if there had been no war between these giants, Nigeria could have received more food intervention aid. Can you all pause for a second and arise while declaring full support for the Guterres-Mohammed current leadership of the United Nations and shout: Let there be peace across the world?!

Casualty figures lost by Ukraine is estimated at 20,000 deaths and 40,000 of her citizens wounded between 24th February, 2022 and 30th November, 2023 ALONE. The United Kingdom estimated that 12,288 to 19,968 Ukrainian citizens were killed.

The Russian military casualties, the official said are approaching 300,000, including 120,000 death cases and 180,000 members of the injured troops.

My pertinent question is: Why the humongous human waste when none of us can create a follicle of the natural human hair? Why the human carnage in the world when peace is a veritable and cheap strategy to embrace? Let the beauty and aroma of peace reign and dominate the world. We are certainly NOT cannibals!

Why is astronomical growth swelling the tide of intolerance when we are ALL creatures of the same merciful and kind God? Why must we succumb to greed, impatience and ego when our stay on earth is for a very limited period. Why are we wasting lives when the power to breath for a second is NOT in our hands and we shall NOT depart the world with a dime of anything we have acquired or stolen?

Henceforth, when any threat to peace comes, why don't we respect the advice and process recommended by the current non-partisan leadership of the United Nations under the pro-active and dynamic duo of Dr. Antonio Gutteres and Dr. Amina Mohammed, both of whom means well for the globe?

Respect for human rights and territorial sovereignty MUST be upheld by the Governments and people of all nations. This is the license that peace needs to be established in all households, communities and nations. Would it not have been possible to avert the most recent Palestinian-Israeli War boiling at the Gaza Trip?

When war trumpets are FIRST blown through the poor crafting of speeches and toxic utterances, those affected by the emitted noise OWE THE WORLD A SACRED DUTY to quickly report it to the United Nations and heed its counsel because NO ONE IS PERMITTED to spill the human blood!
